



Dear Parents,

The State of Florida mandates specific health evaluations and immunizations for children attending Florida schools. Upon your child's entrance into school and each year, it is important that you review these requirements and insure that your child is in compliance with the State regulations.

The mandated health information must be recorded on Florida State forms, which are provided by your Florida medical provider. If your child is entering a Florida school from another state, out-of-state forms are not acceptable. A Florida medical provider must be consulted. **The original, completed form must be returned to school by your child's first day of school or your child will be excluded from school.**

Please review the following Florida State requirements as they pertain to your child.

PHYSICAL EXAMINATION (HRS Form 3040) is mandated for:

➤ Early Childhood (EC-2 through EC-4):

At the time of entry and every year after (must be done within 6 months prior to the start of the school year).

➤ Kindergarten, Grade 7 & New Students Entering:

Must be done within 1 year prior to the start of the school year.

CERTIFICATE OF IMMUNIZATION (HRS Form 680):

➤ Early Childhood:

Part B must be signed and dated by the physician, showing a minimum of the following vaccines:

4 doses of diphtheria, tetanus, pertussis

3 doses of polio

1 dose of measles

1 dose of mumps

1 dose of rubella

4 doses of HIB

3 doses of hepatitis B

1 dose of varicella (chicken pox) or documented history of disease

➤ Kindergarten:

Part A1 must be signed and dated by the physician, showing a minimum of the following vaccines:

5 doses of diphtheria, tetanus, pertussis

4 doses of polio

2 doses of measles

1 dose of mumps

1 dose of rubella

3 doses of hepatitis B

1 dose of varicella (chicken pox) or documented history of disease

➤ Grade 7:

Part A-2 must be signed and dated by the physician, showing a minimum of the following vaccines:

5 doses of diphtheria, tetanus, pertussis

1 dose of tetanus-diphtheria (Td) booster

4 doses of polio

2 doses of measles

1 dose of mumps

1 dose of rubella

3 doses of hepatitis B

1 dose of varicella (chicken pox) or documented history of disease

➤ New School Enterers:

Form must be signed and dated by the physician in the section which applies to the child's grade level, showing a minimum of the mandated immunizations.
