1. <u>Charlotte's Web</u> by E.B. White (ISBN: 978-0061124952) Charlotte's Web is the story of a little girl named Fern who loved a little pig named Wilbur—and of Wilbur's dear friend Charlotte A. Cavatica, a beautiful large grey spider who lived with Wilbur in the barn. With the help of Templeton, the rat who never did anything for anybody unless there was something in it for him, and by a wonderfully clever plan of her own, Charlotte saved the life of Wilbur, who by this time had grown up to quite a pig. How all this comes about is Mr. White's story. It is a story of the magic of childhood on the farm.

2. <u>Tales of a Fourth Grade Nothing</u> by Judy Blume (ISBN: 0142408810) In this classic story, Peter Hatcher feels like a fourth grade "nothing" since his brother Fudge causes problems for him all the time; Fudge always gets away with things at home. So Peter decides that it is time to make his parents pay more attention to him.
