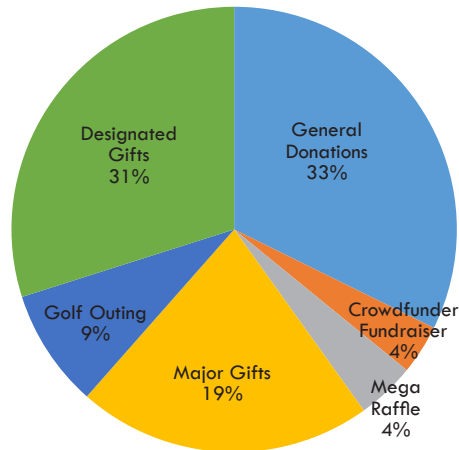

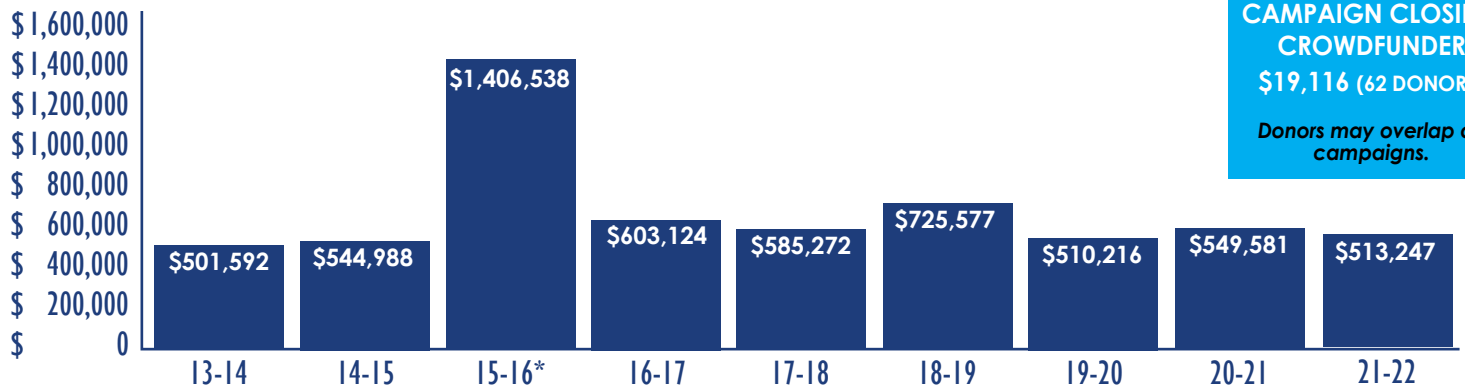

Fundraising History



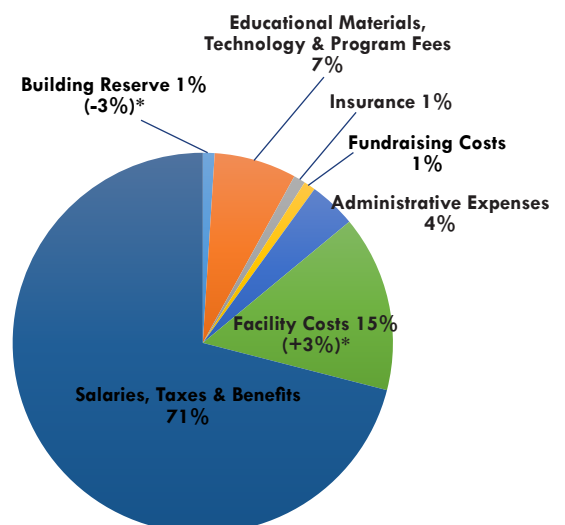
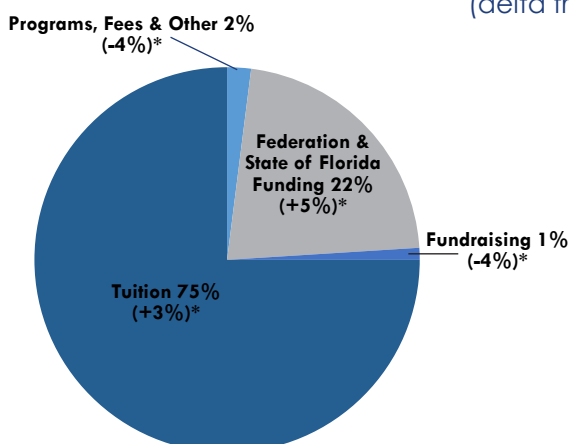

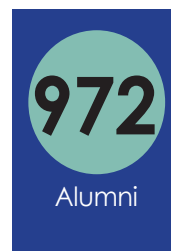
