

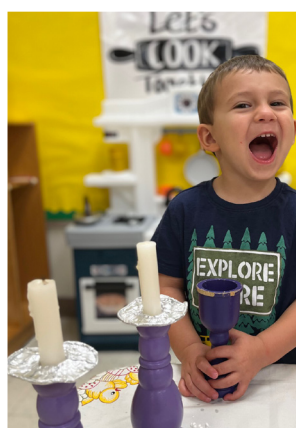

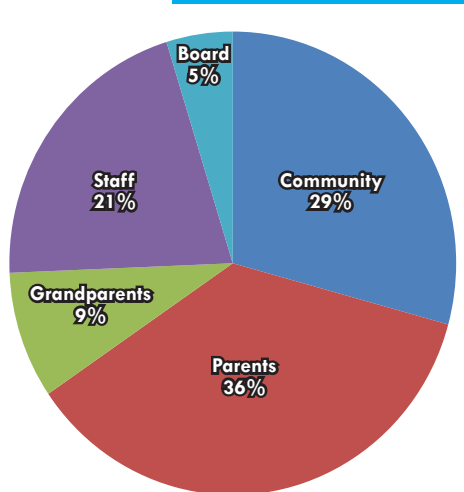

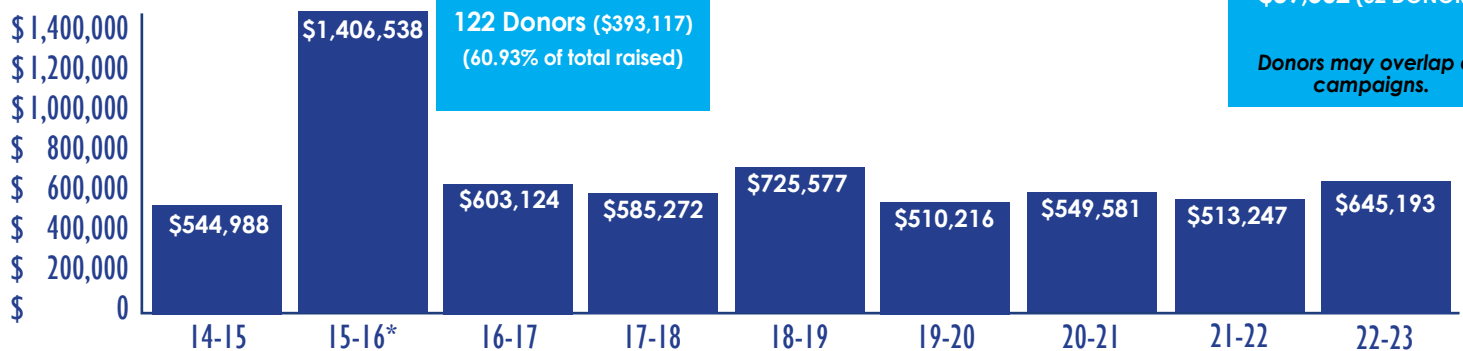

Fundraising History

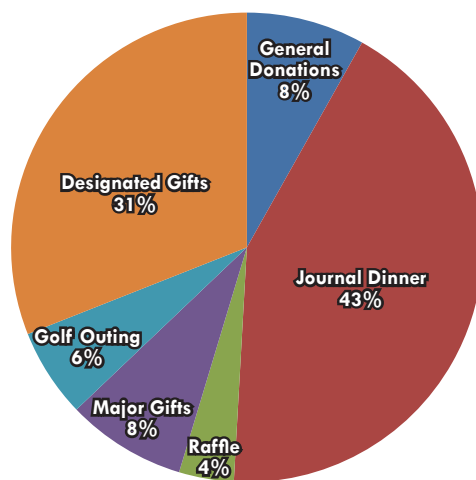

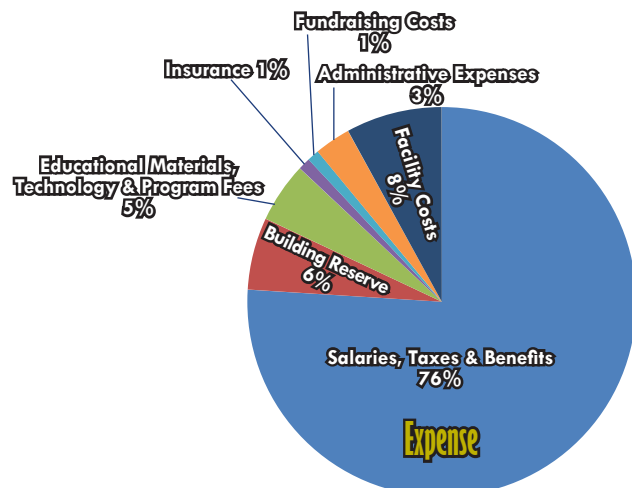
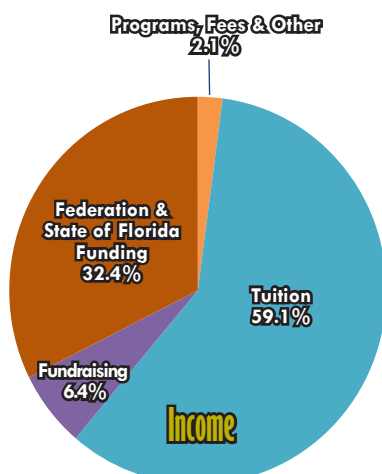
